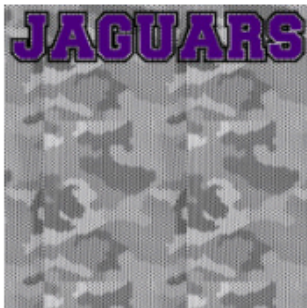

It is a requirement that all athletes in Boys Athletics wear the athletic uniform each class day. The Boys Athletic uniform consists of the *Boys' Athletic shirt* and the *Jaguar shorts* (as seen above).

- **Sports Physical** (click for form) **DUE August 1st** – Each athlete is required to have a sports physical, completed by medical personnel, on file with our coaching staff. A physical is good for one year from the date the exam was completed. Please note that our coaching staff determines a physical's compliance by the date the exam was completed, not the date when the copy was obtained.
Sports physicals can be completed through your primary physician's office, or one can be completed at the following locations:

Rank One Online Forms

- **August 1st** – The online paperwork will be made available on May 1st. This **MUST** be completed before your Athlete may participate in any Athletics activities for the 25-26 school year.

Rank One is an online platform that allows school districts to keep track of athletes' medical history and other required forms along with team rosters, game schedules, and more. RRISD requires that all athletes complete all Rank One online forms prior to participating in Athletics.

Each athlete is required to have all Rank One online forms completed before participating in class. Parents/Guardians will need to create an account on Rank One:

Once an account is created, parents will need to assign their student to the account in the system. (Use their 's' number without the 's' when doing so.) The following forms need to be completed in Rank One:

- Handbook Acknowledgement Form
- Medical History
- UIL Forms Signature Page
- RRISD Parent Consent

Uniform Q&A's

If my athlete has a uniform from the year before, am I required to buy a new one?

No. If your student already has an athletic uniform from a previous year, you do not need to purchase a new uniform for this year unless desired.

Is more than one uniform needed?

We only require that athletes wear the uniform each day to class. The number of uniforms purchased is entirely dependent upon each family's preference. Each class day will likely result in the clothes accumulating sweat, so we typically recommend at least two sets of uniforms. Some athletes prefer to have more shirts than shorts and vice versa. But again, the expectation is only that the uniform be worn each class day, so if an athlete can fulfill that requirement by utilizing one uniform set then only one is needed for purchase. Additional uniform sets are by preference of each family.

Are specific shoes required for the class?

We expect all athletes to come to class each day with running shoes on. Crocs (even in sport mode), sandals, slippers, converse, vans, etc. do not meet the requirements of class expectations. Please reach out to Coach Cearley if you have any questions: Jared_Cearley@roundrockisd.org.
