The project, which commenced approximately 12 months ago, initially focused on providing this functionality exclusively for Windows devices. However, we aim to extend this capability to non-Windows platforms, specifically iOS and Android. Currently, we have developed a basic app framework that loads a web browser, but we are now looking to establish the necessary connectivity for offline functionality.

To achieve offline capability on non-Windows devices, a key requirement is implementing a different data storage layer. Instead of relying on SQL Server, we are transitioning to SQLite for improved cross-platform compatibility. Join our team and contribute to this exciting project that aims to broaden the reach of the app and cater to a wider range of mobile platforms.
