Methodology – State the research design, sampling design, sample size, research procedure(s) including intervention, instrument, and data analysis.

Findings – State the main results of the study. Numerical data may be included but should be kept to a minimum. State the conclusions and implications.

Novelty – State the originality/contribution of the research.

Significance – Who would benefit from this study?
