Agreement for Preschool STEM / Computational Thinking Kit Checkout

Fremont #1 school district received a Wyoming Innovations Grant this school year. One of the facets of the grant is to facilitate the introduction of basic computational thinking concepts to preschool students. To accomplish this, the District has created age-appropriate curriculum kits that eligible preschools may borrow to use with their students in their facilities.

Terms of equipment usage:

- 1 Kits and their contents remain the property of Fremont Co School Dist #1. The program may end at any time at the discretion of District staff due to wear on equipment in kits, neglect of equipment, and other factors.
- 2 District staff will make reasonable efforts to make kits available during the normal school year. Summer availability will be limited.
- 3 Participation is limited to licensed preschools within the operating boundaries of the Fremont #1 school district.
- 4 Preschool directors will affirm that checkout and usage of kits will be for the sole use of preschool students. Kits may not be used for other programs that the entity may sponsor or host (either for-profit or non-profit).
- 5 Kits will be reserved and checked out through an online calendar and form. Phone or email requests for reservations will not be honored. Please allow District staff 1-2 days of processing before equipment is ready for pick-up (assuming it is available on the calendar). No more than two kits may be checked out simultaneously.
- Kits will be checked out and returned through the Central Admin office, at 863 Sweetwater, during normal business hours. Upon return, kits will be checked to ensure all components are present. Kits returned with missing components (or components broken or destroyed) will jeopardize the preschool's participation in the program.
- Preschool directors will be responsible for keeping kits organized and separated from other resources. Kits will only be available as long as they are taken care of. Many kits will require an adult to supervise and lead activities. We strongly encourage you to use strategies (like centers at different tables) that will keep kit contents together and separate from other material in your preschool. An inventory sheet will be included in each kit box for reference.
- A very short evaluation form will be included in each kit. These responses will be used to document program effectiveness to the Wyo Department of Education. Please complete these forms to help us continue the program.

This agreement is valid through the 2020-2021 school year.
