Explain your answer - make an inference based on your background knowledge and what you see in this diagram.</li></ol>
<b>Source 2</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. What type of clothing are the peasants wearing? Describe it.</li><li>2. What type of tools were used for farming?</li><li>3. Who participated in the work of farming the land?</li></ol>
<b>Source 3</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. What was the most important food in a peasant's diet?</li><li>2. Do you think that peasants had enough to eat to sustain all of the energy that they burned? Why or why not? Please cite text evidence to support your answer.</li></ol>
<b>Source 4</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Were animals important to peasants? Cite evidence from this picture to support your claim.</li></ol>

<b>Source 3</b>	1. What caused medieval towns to grow and develop in the late Middle Ages?  2. What was the relationship between free men in towns and their lords?
