Specific regulations for St Michael's Horton:

Please be aware that no member of Horton PCC has the authority to make decisions regarding requests for memorials in the churchyard. We can guide you to the [literature explaining the rules](#)* and can comment, from experience, on the probable likelihood of an application being approved, but we do not decide in any situations.

(* There may be some slight relaxing of the rules relating to the "Design" section, but that is dependent on the Associate ArchDeacon assessing the application and cannot be assumed).

Please note that any consent is to the dimensions specified - this means that no extra marble may be subsequently added to increase the size, and that all pots and other additions must be **on** the grave not around the outside. This is to preserve the very few remaining burial spaces in the churchyard.

Fees should be submitted to the relevant church (see below), and confirmation of the payment sent to Office@CHWChurches.org. We will let you know our decision as soon as possible.
