
Content & Personal Development Grades - If a teacher ties standard (aka content area and personal development grades) to assignments and has their **Auto-Calculate Assignment Standards Scores Initial State** (on the Settings>Display Settings page) to *New Assignments Start Checked*, then trimester content area and personal development grade will calculate. Also Y1 Content Area and Personal Development grades will be calculated.

If teachers manually enter trimester Content Area and Personal Development Grades, then teacher needs to manually enter these grades for Y1. T3 will not have personal development grades this year (2019-2020)

To manually enter content and personal development grades:

1. Select class to work with
2. Click on the Grading Charm
3. Click on Standards
4. The page will display with the student's names, Term and however many standards (aka content) columns.
5. If a teacher hovers their mouse over the column heading a box will display indicating the standard (aka content) grade to be assessed.



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

Final Term Grades Kindergarten students are stored (Historical Grades) even though they do not appear on report card.




