

## CLAIM TESTING: GLOBAL CONFLICT

### Purpose

Use your knowledge of claim testing to write supporting statements for claims, and then craft counterclaims. Then, strengthen both your writing and claim-testing skills by choosing one claim and writing a paragraph.

### Process

- For each claim below, write **two** supporting statements *and* a counterclaim, using evidence from this unit. Reminder: A counterclaim is a statement or argument that goes against a claim and offers an opposing viewpoint.

**Claim 1:** *Both World War I and II were total wars.*

*(Note: Total war includes four key elements: mobilization, the rejection of compromise agreements, the blurring of lines between soldiers and civilians, and total control of society by the government.)*
