A. Ethics

The publication of an academic article in a peer-reviewed journal is an important effort for the development of a discipline knowledge. In order to maintain its publication quality, Architecture Innovation will always do peer-review for every article submitted to the journal. It is therefore important to agree upon standards of expected behavior which include the authorship, multi-author works, originality and plagiarism, and conflict of interest.

B. Authorship

Architecture Innovation defines authorship as the state of being the writer of an academic article based on substantial intellectual contribution. In an academic article, there may be more than 1 (one) author. Therefore, the list of authors should be provided. It is important that the list of authors includes all of those and only those who had a significant role in the article.

C. Multi-Author Works

In the case of multi-author works, authors must agree on and designate a corresponding author before the submission of their manuscript. The corresponding author has additional responsibilities to:

- 1. Ensuring that all appropriate co-authors are listed for the work
- 2. Obtaining from all co-authors their consent and approval of the final version accepted for publication
- 3. Keeping all co-authors apprised of the article's status

D. Originality and Plagiarism

The authors should ensure that they have written entirely original works, based on their own research and/or experience; and if the authors have used the work and/or words of others, this must have been cited or quoted properly. Plagiarism is defined as the use of someone else's ideas, researches, or words without explicitly acknowledging the original author and source. Architecture Innovation does not accept any form of plagiarism and therefore it is considered as a serious breach of professional conduct.

E. Conflict of Interest

In submitting his/their work, all authors must include disclosure of all relationships that could be viewed as presenting a potential conflict of interest in his/their research.
