Section 6.2: Reevaluation

Early Intervention

23. For a child transitioning from early intervention into kindergarten, may a LEA adopt or revise the IEP for a child with a disability category of developmental delay (DD) for kindergarten?

Yes. LEAs may adopt or revise the current preschool early intervention IEP and issue a NOREP/PWN to provide services in kindergarten.

24. Must LEAs conduct a reevaluation for a child with a disability category of developmental delay (DD) prior to beginning kindergarten when transition from preschool early intervention?

No. LEAs must consider each child individually to determine if a reevaluation is necessary prior to beginning kindergarten. LEAs must reevaluate each child prior to the child reaching the LEA's age of beginners.

25. May a LEA identify a school-age child as having a developmental delay (DD) following a school-age reevaluation?

No. A LEA may not identify a child with DD once they begin kindergarten.

26. Will a kindergarten student who transitioned from early intervention who has a diagnosis of DD be included in the December 1 Child Count collection?

No. DD is not a reportable disability category for the December 1 Child Count.
