

# Daily Highlights

## Week of January 5

### Monday

- Our first day back started with IN MORNING, but by recess students were enjoying the new snow and sunshine. We spent lots of time reconnecting this morning and talking about our holiday break. We reviewed letters and sounds we know and had a short introduction to the letter Ee. After snack, we had gym with Ms Hanlon. We sang Personal Penguin, had a story called "Yawn" and did a yawning craft. In the afternoon, we had a quiet time, did our new January Number Corner, and had a choosing day at Centers. ### Tuesday

- We started the day with Heggerty and then reviewing the formation of numbers 0-5 on mini whiteboards. We worked with the letter Ee, completing race track letters, red duotangs and coloring Edna Elephant. We had snack, exploration bins, and then library book exchange, followed by an elephant Directed Drawing. In the afternoon, we watched some Ee episodes, did Number Corner, loaded mail and had a center choosing day, which included a penguin craft.

### Wednesday

- Today we began to explore the number 6 (different ways to show 6, what numbers add to make six and the formation of 6). We did our Ee Sound Journals and had gym with Ms Hanlon. We had Number Corner in the morning, read *The Hat* by Jan Brett and made crayon resist toques that we painted in the afternoon. We played a ten frame hockey math game with our Big Buddies and had another choosing day at Centers.

### Thursday

- This morning we did a Heggerty (oral language) lesson, more work with the number 6 and played some math games. After snack, Ms Hanlon did a Social Emotional Learning lesson with the class, we made pom poms for our crayon resist

toques and we began learning about the five senses. In the afternoon, we had a Quiet time, did Number Corner, read a story, and began our first rotation of new centers (knights, Little People Community, Ello and Polly Pockets).

## **Friday**

- This morning we read some word blends with Ee and did a work job practicing to identify the beginning and ending sound in a word. We did an introduction to the number 7 and did rainbow sevens and a bit of work in our math duotangs. We did a penguin Directed Drawing and had an assembly in the gym. In the afternoon we watched some short videos about Ee and a Canada Crew episode.
