- 1. Login to Putty with the user. (do not su to another user)
- 2. Type screen → this will start a new "Virtual Terminal"
- 3. Do the work in this virtual Terminal.
- 4. If you need to disconnect from the "Virtual Terminal", press **ctrl+A+D** all together. Please note it will only disconnect "your" session but the virtual terminal will still be running in the background.
- 5. Type "w" to verify the virtual terminal
