

MALAGA MARKETS

Malaga offers a wide variety of markets that run almost every day of the week, from traditional neighborhood stalls to cultural flea markets and craft markets in the port.

Traditional Neighborhood Markets

These markets are usually open from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and offer local clothing, footwear, accessories, and products.

Here are the main markets divided by the day of the week:

Wednesdays and Sundays (The Biggest)

Sunday: Cortijo de Torres Market (Fairgrounds). It is the main and largest flea market in the city with more than 300 stalls. It is located on Avenida de las Malagueñas.

Justification: Ideal for finding everything from food to second-hand clothing and items.

Wednesdays and Saturdays: Huelin Market (Avenida Europa). Very popular and with a family atmosphere, with about 150 stalls.

Other days of the week

Monday: Martíricos (next to La Rosaleda stadium) and Campanillas.

Tuesday: Traditionally there is less activity in the capital, although in nearby towns such as Fuengirola its main market is held on this day.

Wednesday:

Huelin (Avenida de Europa): One of the most popular and largest with a wide variety of stalls.

Cortijo de Torres: Located in the Fairgrounds.

Virgen de Belén: It has about 86 gift and fashion stalls.

Thursday: Ciudad Jardín Market (Av. Jacinto Benavente) and Cruz de Humilladero.

Friday: Los Corazones and Miraflores de los Ángeles.

Saturdays: In addition to the one in Huelin, the one in El Palo (Plaza Virgen de la Milagrosa) and the one in Arroyo del Cuarto are celebrated.

Huelin (Avenida de Europa): It is repeated in the same location as on Wednesday.

El Palo: Located in the Plaza Virgen de la Milagrosa.

El Rastro and Sunday Markets

Sunday is the main day for lovers of antiques and curiosities.

Rastro de Málaga: It is the largest market in the city. It is held at the Cortijo de Torres Fairgrounds from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., with more than 300 antique and second-hand stalls.

Soho Urban Market: A craft and design market held on the fourth Sunday of each month (next dates: April 26 and May 24, 2026) on Tomás Heredia Street, from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Special Markets and Crafts

Muelle Uno: Hosts craft and fashion markets frequently. Currently, the Winter Market is available until May 15, 2026, opening daily from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

La Térmica (Red Friday): A night-time cultural trail with music and gastronomy that is held on specific dates. The next editions confirmed for 2026 are on June 5 and October 2, from 6:00 p.m. to 00:00 a.m.

Ecological Markets: Organized by Guadalhorce Ecológico, they usually rotate around the city. For example, on the second Saturday of the month in Huelin Park.
