SUBJECT: Dixie Police Reform Initiatives

(I) Short Title

- (a) This Directive shall be titled "DoJ Directive #70 : Implementation of B. 601".

(II) Ensuring Compliance with the Police Use of Force Policy

- (a) The Dixie Commission on Police Misconduct (D.C.P.M.) is hereby ordered to send out a copy of the Police Use of Force Policy as described in B. 601 to all local and state law enforcement agencies. Forms will also be sent out across the state to be signed by every officer employed by a state or local law enforcement agency. They agree to the following:
- (i) That they have read and agree to the Police Use of Force Policy;
 - (ii) That if a complaint is filed and an investigation is initiated by the D.C.P.M. you will be suspended without pay.
- (b) The Law Enforcement Misconduct Portal (L.E.M.P.) is hereby directed to receive, store, and audit the Forms sent out by the D.C.P.M. The files shall be stored

digitally in the L.E.M.P. database as well as hard copies kept in a secure storage facility in the Attorney General's office.

- (c) I hereby certify that the D.C.P.M. Policy on Police Misconduct meets and/or exceeds the requirements defined in B. 601: Police Use of Force Reform Act.
- (d) I hereby allocate \$15,000,000 from the Department of Justice discretionary spending to fund the aforementioned directive.

(III) Enactment

- (a) This Directive shall take effect immediately upon posting.
