SEPARATION AND DELINEATION

“We should expect that what God is separating and delineating now will help us see more clearly what is being birthed for the future.”

1. What separations or distinctions do you see God making right now, personally? In the world at large? Can you identify the new things God might be “birthing” or creating through those separations?
2. Study Proverbs 3:5-6 & John 15:5. On the surface, the idea of maturity does not seem synonymous with dependence. How does Kingdom maturity differ from the world’s concept of maturity? Do you consider yourself to be wholly dependent on God, or confident in your own abilities?

COME OUT FROM AMONG THEM

2 Corinthians 6:14 describes 5 unholy partnerships: believers yoked with unbelievers; righteousness with wickedness; light with darkness; Christ and Satan; the temple of God and idols. Those who desire to become sons and daughters of the Father must distinguish between holy and unholy.

- 3 Are there areas in your life where you are partnering with evil or compromise? Is it possible that these things hinder your ability to know God intimately as a Father?
4. In this season where God is searching our hearts and examining our minds, what is He exposing in your life as a “crutch” or an idol? What do you need to do to separate yourself from these idols and “soar” in the Spirit?

ASCENDING IN THE SPIRIT

Deborah saw a vision of an airplane taking off, whose passengers were those who were yielding to the upward call of the Holy Spirit. This yieldedness came through a choice to depart from the old and trust that the Lord - their Pilot - would bring them into the new.

5. Spiritual “ascent” often looks more like natural “descent!” It includes discipline, time in the Word and prayer, denial of self, and waiting upon the Lord. Have you taken the time to rest and be still with the Lord? Have you “boarded” this plane called “trust” which enables you to ascend to the Father?

6. If you have been caught up in the busyness of “life as usual,” what can you do now to embark on your own spiritual journey with the Holy Spirit?

BY FAITH

7. Read Hebrews 11 & 12: Can you give an unqualified “Yes” to the Lord to live by faith, even without knowing where He will take you? Why or why not? What obstacles do you find in your own heart?

8. Read Galatians 3: What does it mean to you to “walk in the Spirit” and not gratify the desires of the flesh? Do you strive to control outcomes or trust by faith that God will fulfill His promises to you?

MOVERS AND SHAKERS

God promises to open up new opportunities for those who remove blinders from their eyes and pay attention to what He is showing them.

9 Act on this word: PRAY for an uncovering of all that has blinded you to the light and truth of God’s glory. Ask the Lord to lift veils of fear and unbelief from your eyes. Pray for clear eyes to see what is coming.

10. Are you allowing God to lead you or fighting against where He is taking you? What promises have you heard from God for your life, your family, your church or your region? How can you connect your faith to those promises so that you become part of God’s movement?

JESUS IS THE WAY!

11. In prayer, ask the Lord to show you places of doubt, fear, or unbelief that would keep you from moving forward by faith this year. Then, read Galatians 4:30. BY FAITH, renounce whatever has been birthed illegitimately out of your own fleshly desires. Ask the Lord to help you stand in faith to see the fulfillment of His promises for you.

12. Are you okay with not knowing your next destination this year (if it has not yet been revealed to you) and resting in Him until He shows you? Do you trust Jesus, the “Pilot” who says He IS the way? Do you believe that God’s plan – and your destination – are good? If not, pray for the grace to let go of any remaining fears and old habits so that God can bring you into the new things He is preparing for you!

CHOOSE TO BELIEVE, NOT TO DESPAIR

13. What is the one condition in Psalm 27:13 which must be met for us to see God’s goodness in our world?

14. Read Exodus 33:19 & Exodus 34:5–6. Write out the definition God provides of His own goodness & glory.
