### 2. Camp Guidelines (see more details on the website)

- a. YW and leaders leaving early will need to coordinate with other wards
- b. No YW allowed to drive themselves
- c. Alternate activity will be on-site at the activity for white-water rafting, and the hike. We highly encourage all YW and leaders to participate in the main activity!
- d. No food in cabins because of wildlife in the area. Snacks will be available in the lodge, as well as drink stations throughout the camp.
- e. Buddy-system will be used throughout the week at camp
- f. Limited cell coverage and no power in cabins
- g. YW are highly encouraged to leave electronics at home or in cabins.

### 3. Ward Assignments

- a. Each ward provides a 10'x10' canopy, a camp chair for each person, a 5-gallon water cooler with spout, cooler for transporting lunches on Mon & Tues
- b. Each ward provides transportation for their own YW to/from the Alpine 4-H camp (4.5 hr drive), to the Tuesday hike in Jackson at Jenny Lake (45 min drive), and to/from the Rafting transport bus in Alpine (10 min drive) on Wednesday
- c. Each ward provides a trailer or luggage space for your own YW and leaders supplies and gear
- d. At camp, each ward will be assigned a cabin for YW leaders and girls.

- e. At camp, there will be multiple drink stations for refilling water bottles. These stations are made up of the 5-gallon drink coolers each ward is bringing. Your ward will be in charge of making sure your 5 gallon water cooler is refilled a few times during the day so that we have plenty of water available at all times to avoid dehydration.
- f. At camp, we will be assigning each ward to help with 1 meal cleanup or prep, depending on what our camp chefs are needing. More details to come!

#### **4. Transportation**

- Driving directions
- Possibly combining wards in vehicles to allow for church guidelines
- Coordinating between wards for YW needing to leave early
- Reimbursements for gas

#### **5. Other things to be aware of:**

- a. We will have the camp daily schedules posted at the lodge and bathrooms, as well as in the camp booklets that each person will receive.
- b. Due to disrepair of the camp bathrooms, we have 3 flushing toilets and 3 port-a-potties
- c. We have limited access to showers, so will only have the showers available to wards at specific times. Showers will need to be short and flip-flops worn during the showers. We ask ward YW leaders to coordinate this with your girls, thank you for your help! :)
- d. As we get final registrations we will assign wards their individual cabins
- e. If you have a National Parks Pass, we will need them to get into the Jenny Lakes hike activity on Tuesday. If you don't have one, you can be reimbursed
- f. DO You know someone that is an EMT, nurse, Doctor or someone with significant first aid experience , that could come to camp with us.
