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Educators for Peace is under an evidence-free smear attack from UK Lawyers for Israel and their Genocide denying supporters. The above 'lawfare' attack against Educators for Peace, by those seeking to silence all mention of Palestine, is a losing position. This morning British anti-Zionist academic Dr David Miller won a decisive legal victory at the Employment Appeal Tribunal, which ruled that his anti-Zionist worldview is 'worthy of respect in a democratic society' and should be a protected philosophical belief under the Equality Act 2010. **Zionism is racism. It must end.** Palestinians are entitled to the same human rights as any other citizen of our world.

MAGS by another name! Mothers Against Genocide Scotland has collectively agreed to rebrand as M/others Against Genocide Scotland, saying this is a small change that reflects what's always been at the heart of who they are; and the movement we want to continue building. The / is an invitation. They want to be more explicit in welcoming everyone into this community—parents, non-parents, their LGBTQIA+ siblings, people whose lives took different paths, chosen families, and all who stand against genocide and believe in collective action. ***"Founded by Glasgow maws. Open to all"***.

Hope for my Family: The year-long campaign has now reached almost two-thirds of the target. If you missed this, it is a campaign by a Glasgow Palestinian family to raise funds for relatives in Gaza.
