

On Saturday Oct. 2nd, CAC volunteers (Staff, PTO, Booster club and administrators) delivered CAC donations to the *Maana L enkaz Ensan Homeless* homeless shelter located in Boulak, Cairo. The donations were Arabic books, carpets, boards from the ES division, clothing and canned food from the HS Spirit week in addition to other donations by the community members.

"Maa'na Lenkaz Ensan" means "together to save a human being". The founder, Mahmoud Waheed who is an engineer started this foundation in 2013 with the dream to provide a shelter for anyone who had no place to go to and was forced to stay in the street. The organization works on the transformation of a homeless person into becoming a productive human being.
