### 9) Accreditation Updates

- Changes at the state level
- This is considered a “Learning Year” for all districts.
- We will have yearly check-ins with KSDE regional supervisors
- Instead of an OVT (Outside Visitation Team) we now have options and have chosen to partner with “Like-Systems” for our annual review.
- As a reminder, we are in our second year of our 5 year cycle. Our goals for this cycle are:
  - Academic Goal (#1)
    - By the end of the 2026-2027 school year, 85% of students will score in levels 2-4 on the state assessments in reading.
  - Mental Health (BSEL) Goal (#2)
    - By the end of the 2026-2027 school year, students in grades 6,8,10,12 will score equal to or better than the Kansas average on every question in the Protective Factor subcategory of Student Voice on the KCTC Climate Types Report.
