

Federalism 2.0. Congress should be the nation's premier content connector for shared public purpose, a data distributor in support of modern democracy and Article One in the US Constitution. Here is the **First Branch LLM Concept map**. This is the enterprise level infrastructure that will create accessible, accountable and permanent information resources for use by the public and lawmakers. It is a sensemaking layer to benefit lawmaking in the public interest. These resources will also build a more inclusive record for statutory clarity and interpretation—critical in the post Chevron Congress.(See Supreme Court Loper-Bright decision) Note the constituent voice component, which is newly possible due to the rise of non profit deliberative technology and voice into data capture and labelling. Authentication thru in person and human vouched-for information will become more critical as AGI advances.
