


LESSON TITLE: World Teacher Day	LESSON GOAL: The students will learn to make airplane flyers, chart the flight distance and watch a video about the science of paper airplane flight.
BOOK: My Teacher Is A Monster by Peter Brown	<p><u>Introduction:</u> The Book today is called My Teacher is A Monster by Peter Brown. Why do you think a child might think their teacher is a monster?</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Video Link 2. Ask: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why did Bobby think his teacher was a monster? • Have you ever seen a teacher when you were not at school? What did you think? • What did Bobby do to help his teacher in the park? • What did Miss Kerby give to Bobby in the park?
<p>ACTIVITY: Airplane Flight Challenge</p> <p>SUPPLIES NEEDED: Paper Airplane Flight Challenge sheet, paper airplane templates. Please make copies at Teacher Center.</p> 	<p><u>Introduction:</u> When the teacher gave the boy his paper airplane, he knew she wasn't really a monster. Today we are going to have an Airplane Flight Challenge.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. We will start with a short video about paper airplane flight. Factors That Affect Paper Airplane Flight (The Science of flight, lift, gravity, thrust & drag) 2. After the activity, ask: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What did you think of this activity? Did you have fun? • Did learning about lift, gravity, thrust & drag help you make and fly the plane better? • What else did you learn about paper airplane making or flying?
<p>GROUP GAME: <u>Developmental Goal:</u> To work on eye-foot coordination and teamwork. <u>Equipment Needed:</u> Balls</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Read through the game instructions ahead of time so that you can teach the activity. 2. Use an attention-getter to gather students and make sure they are listening. 3. Explain the game, the rules, and how to play the game. 4. Check for understanding, have a few kids and staff demonstrate play. 5. Link to game: Crab Soccer
