The author is asked to formulate the problem in a concrete and clear way in this section. Explain the objectives to be achieved in the devotional activity.

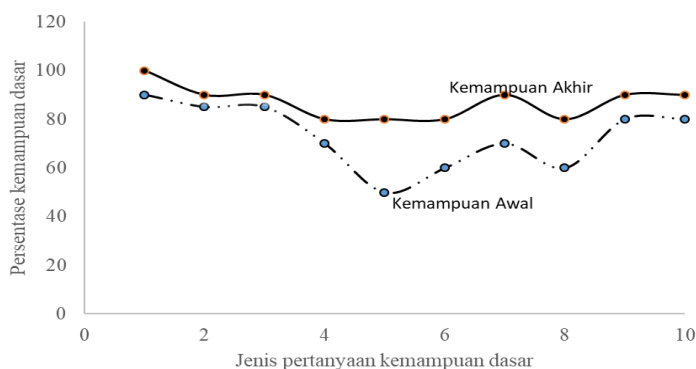


Figure 3. Basic proficiency test results (%) of participants in training of patin fish farmers tested at the beginning and end of devotional activities

For good article quality to be published, the editor requires the author to use a primary reference (journal) with a composition of at least 80% compared to other references on the library list. The author is asked to use the latest references published in the last 5 years. This journal does not use footnotes on the script body, all library sources follow the quotation writing rules and the Library List.

The quotation format in the script and the library list view on **Jurnal Hasil Pengabdian Masyarakat (JURIBMAS)** following *American Psychological Association (APA)* and using the Mendeley tool. All quotations in the text must be included in the reference, and all references must be mentioned within the text. Check the library list of quotes in text before submitting the script.

In-text citations must be the same as in the Library List. These citations are followed by or ended by a sentence or phrase quoted from the source. In the manuscript they are quoted by including the last name of the author following the year of publication of the quoted article. All references must be mentioned in the text and must be written with complete information. The author's name, journal or book title, article or chapter title, year of publication, volume, edition number (if any), and page number are important components of the library list. Add a DOI number (if available) or recommended article URL. The core components of writing Library List for journal articles using the APA format are as follows:

Author's last name, initials. (year-on-year). Article title, Journal name, Volume number, page. DOI address or Retrieved from URL

For example, a writer with the name Almasdi Syahza becomes "Syahza, A.", an author with three words such as Muhammad Nur Mustafa becomes "Mustafa, M. N.", while the author with one word such as Hapsah is typed "Hapsah".

Writing of APA format references varies widely depending on the type of reference quoted in the script. Here are some examples of writing.
