

Open Letter to the University of Guelph Central Student Association (CSA)

We, the undersigned organizations, call for the CSA to refuse the accreditation of Guelph Students Supporting Israel (GSSI). This call is based on the CSA's own mandate, as described in its Policy and Bylaw Manual, whereby the CSA "work[s] to build a community on-and off-campus free from all forms of oppression. [They] run services and events that support students including students from marginalized groups."¹

Obviously, Guelph students can take any personal position they wish in regards to the state of Israel. But an organization: 1) dedicated to the support of a foreign government – Israel – which is accused of apartheid by major human rights organizations, and 2) dedicated to showing "the good" that a colonial movement – Zionism – "has caused" is an organization that *supports oppression*. If it permits the accreditation of GSSI, the CSA will have failed to uphold its anti-oppression mandate.

All of the major human rights organizations of the world, including [Amnesty International](#)², [Human Rights Watch](#)³, and Israel-based [B'Tselem](#)⁴ have recently issued reports detailing how Israel is practicing apartheid against Palestinians. If this weren't enough, late last year, the new government that formed in Israel has been [described](#) as the "most right-wing in Israel's history."⁵ Itamar Ben-Gvir, the leader of the Otzma Yehudit party, who recently became the Minister of National Security and has control over the police in Israel and the West Bank is known for his anti-Arab remarks and has [urged](#) for a loosening of the laws governing when security forces may open fire on Palestinian civilians.⁶

While some may claim today that Zionism is simply about the "self-determination of the Jewish people," this is historical revisionism. In the early 20th century, the founders of the Zionist movement openly [described](#) Zionism as colonialism.^{7 &} Max Nordau, for example, [wrote](#), "Zionism rejects on principle all colonization on a small scale, and the idea of 'sneaking' into Palestine. The Zionists have therefore devoted themselves preeminently to a zealous and tireless advocacy of the uniting of the already existing Jewish colonies in Palestine."⁸ Israeli settler colonialism [continues](#) today with the aim of bringing all Palestinian land under Israeli sovereignty and expelling all indigenous Palestinians.¹⁰

Members of the Guelph Palestinian Student Association (GPSA) can personally attest to the harms and oppression that members and their families have endured and continue to endure today as a result of Israel's apartheid practices and settler-colonial origins.

As a student union representing students on campus, the CSA should make the effort to understand the brutal realities faced by Palestinians under Israeli apartheid and military occupation. It should also listen to the voices of University of Guelph students who have been directly affected by Israel's violent founding ideologies. Ultimately, if the CSA allows GSSI to operate and advertise itself in the University Center, the university demonstrates that its "commitment to decolonization" is meaningless.

We reiterate: do not allow for the accreditation of the GSSI.
