#### **Agenda Items / Discussion**

The committee confirmed the decisions from the previous meeting and, reflecting the support expressed by members, noted the following keynote candidate suggestions:

- **Kim Hyeon:** Nominated by local organizers as a representative of the host country, recognized for pioneering Digital Humanities in Korea and witnessing its disciplinary transition.
- **Kirsten Thorpe:** Noted for contributions to Indigenous data sovereignty, Asia-Pacific regional representation, and cultural engagement, aligning with the conference theme.
- **Patricia Murrieta-Flores:** Noted for positive interactions with PC members and a reputation as an engaging and collegial speaker.
- The suggestion of Han Kang, the Nobel Prize—winning author, was discussed, but it was noted that she generally avoids public appearances and has declined multiple invitations.

The committee agreed to conduct a vote, with each PC member allotted two votes, as up to two additional keynote speakers may be nominated. The results will produce a ranked list of candidates to be invited.
