Students aged 16 to 18 who are considering studying law at a UK university, may be interested in this six-week long University of Cambridge online course. Whether they already know that they want to study law at university, are considering their options, or are just curious about the law, this course will give them a useful introduction to studying law at university. Students can join for free to get access to the course for 6 weeks, with around 24 hours of study in total. They can enrol on the six-week course up until Monday 9th March 2026.
