The Sunday morning youth is a group that young people leave the church service for after the sung worship. The aim of this group is to teach young people about Jesus and to introduce them to a way of living life that reflects those teachings.

Volunteering Role:

Volunteering for this does not sign you up to lead the group or to have anything to add to the rest of your week.

General Team: All that is required is to be in the room, to help facilitate a friendly and conversational space. There is also a little light breakfast clean up to do. You will not be asked to lead or prepare a session. This can be arranged as time goes on, but only with clear communication.
