- Provide the accommodations specified on the IEP in the general education classroom.
- Document the provision of accommodations. If it is not documented it didn't happen.

1. Which students in my class have IEPs?
2. Have I personally reviewed each IEP?
3. Do I remember what these documents say?
4. Am I implementing each IEP?
5. Do I have proof that I am implementing the IEPs?
