(prenote, very fallible in all things except that Jesus Christ is wholly God, the beginning, and the life of all things)

Vague structure -begin with revelation -spit out what is false -eat what remains

Many have compared the Christian God to a flying spaghetti monster. Though such a charitable comparison cannot address the Trinity, of which, who can understand the mysteries? It would be better compared to the God of non-existence, who does not exist, yet by mystery has created all things.

As it is written, if you confess "Jesus is Lord", and believe that he was raised from the dead by God, you will be saved. But who exactly is Jesus? Could I take a fly for my Lord, call him Jesus, crucify him, wait until his death, and then resuscitate him? Look, has not God allowed for Jesus, who is Lord, to be raised from the dead? Have two people ever in their minds conceived of the same Jesus? What lines could you possibly draw?

See the esteemed mentor who goes out of his way to guide others. He deceives them onto his trodden path, so he might more easily forget the emptiness he feels at his end. We are ourselves, and what from the self is not for the self? Who then can do good?

See also the kamikaze pilot who flies into a boat. He makes no sacrifice, for though his body perishes, he believes that he will live on as his nation and in the memory of those on earth, greater than if he had not. Who can say that we are not ourselves owned purely by ourselves? For what authority we allow others to take over us, we must first authorise.

And even if we could entirely submit, how could we to a truth outside ourselves? For who can submit themselves to a truth that they do not understand? And if you understand the truth, then it is not the truth to which you submit, but your own understanding beneath it.

Truly, we are all our own many Gods. And how miserable the world has been for it since Adam and Eve ate of the fruit. But take heart, for Christ has overcome this world. As much as you understand death, you will understand life. I am the tree, and I have eaten only what has been given by my Father.

Let us find certainty, objective truth must exist. As we all by existence assert a claim of truth on the world. In trying to doubt this, we only claim another truth. The many who say 'all truth is subjective' merely throne themselves with objective truth, and rarely do they look down from their imaginary towers. Those who try escaping only chase a goal infinitely close, but never touching.

The truth is Christ our God, just as he said plainly, 'I am the truth'. Those who seek to justify Christ only try making Gods of themselves. At their end, they hold up only a name, butchered into conformity. Christ is the beginning, and there is nothing apart from him.

I cannot imagine an argument to support Christ's deity without my throat seizing as though I were beginning to vomit. Please, I pray that we stop this nonsense, for my throat and for our salvation.

What exists not in relation exists not at all. Therefore, God, who exists prior to all else, must exist with internal relation. There is one God in three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. For the question of same-sex marriage, or women's ordination, is it not clear already? There is only one Son of God, and all who believe in him are Sons of God also. All persons in Jesus Christ are married already, and there is neither male and female.

See the many bishops of England who desecrate scripture for women's ordination and same-sex marriage, are there any among them not infested by demons? But even so, their authority in the church is clean. So is often of Christ to use what is dead to give life. And is it not obvious that even the many worshippers of idols may hold the authority to teach from God? For

if it were not so, it would necessitate the grace of God for some persons of earth to teach, and such a demand is too vile for words. Dissent from your church in the way you would as a baby reject your mother and crawl onto the street.

Christ fulfils many roles, among them the jester, for if you combined every madman of history, they could never conceive of a world as laughable as ours. And the Lord laughs at the wicked, for he knows their end, but their end may not be as you suspect. So, we live on the edge of a revolving chaos, in which the Lord provides us calm waters. Who could understand these things and not laugh many thousands of times?

To give eyesight to the blind is of no difficulty, but for them to open their own eyes, the challenge is great. Has any person ever understood the truth without first wrestling with him? So, I have written not to explain anything that you might understand, only to give a short taste.

The many who seek knowledge so that they might believe or disbelieve, they will find their many reasons, and they will be empty. But the one who seeks only Christ, which is truth, goodness, and beauty, they will be filled.

It is better that you should wrestle with one good sentence than to read a thousand books. And better that you should find one idea yourself than to hear a hundred others (even mine \bigcirc). Do not be like the babblers who read their many babbling books. They wrestle with their pride and are blinded by it. All I have said can be summarised in this: Christ is the way, the truth, and the life, and none come to the Father except through him.

As a young child, I had a vision of an angel. But still, I could not believe, for my heart was greatly hardened. But these words are more beautiful than any vision, for they are the Lord God, in whose eyes you may gaze and see all things reflected. And who could understand these things and not weep many thousands of times?

And now, I am become the revelation and the life, the giver of all truth that my Father has given to me. As are you, if you hold onto the truth given to you in heart and mind.

If you have found value in one of my words, and want to find understanding, it is best that you dissect me wholly with your own hands. And what is my word is not only my word but equally the word of all Christians. (If you see something wrong or badly written, feel free to make improvements).

If you wish to discuss your ideas with me, then pray. All that has been given to me is from my Father. And he will give you all things appropriate. You need only be to him as a child.
