

Spectrum Music Uniform Information

The Spectrum Music Department is proud to offer a formal uniform for every instrumental ensemble. These are professionally cleaned, mended in the summer and tailored in the fall during uniform sizing night.

Before the first concert, please make sure you have found the following items to be worn with ALL band uniforms:

- 1.) A pair of plain LONG black socks (NO athletic or socks with logos)
- 2.) A white button down long sleeved dress shirt. (Must be able to hold a tie, NO golf or knit shirts)

As mentioned above, The Spectrum Music Department provides the following items on a yearly rental basis (**see rental info page 11**):

Sr. Concert Band/Marching Band – Tuxedo jacket and pants, orange tie, black band shoes.

Jr. Concert Band – Green sweater, tuxedo pants, yellow tie, black band shoes.

Sr. Jazz Band – blue vest, blue tie, tuxedo pants, black band shoes.

Jr. Jazz Band – red vest, red tie, tuxedo pants, black band shoes.

Each band member retains the same uniform during the school year, unless it is necessary to change size. Uniforms are stored at the school for convenience.

*Off-Site events like Festivals, Community Concerts etc. will require students to take everything home the night before. **When able, please arrange to pick up your student the day before to help maintain the integrity of the uniform(s) crease and fold.***

SPECTRUM MUSIC UNIFORM RENTAL AGREEMENT

There is one non-refundable fee in the Spectrum Music Department. All members must provide a cheque for \$30.00 (OR CASH-RECEIPT PROVIDED). These are cashed immediately and placed in our Uniform account for our yearly maintenance, cleaning and repair of uniforms/shoes.

Both Cash or Cheque are due **FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 23rd, 2022.**

- * Cheques are required before uniforms are issued.

- * No student will be denied a uniform due to financial hardship.

A student in the music program will be charged via Cash School Online if the following items are lost or returned in poor condition (Torn, ripped, permanently stained). Please review the list before completing the contract.

Bow-Tie (Blue, Red): \$15.00

Blazer: \$60.00

Pants: \$45.00

Shoes: \$35.00

It is agreed that:

- 1) The uniform(s) will be treated with care.
- 2) Tuxedo jackets, pants, vests, and ties will Not be washed or altered in any way.
- 3) The Uniform Maintenance payment of \$30.00 will be paid before the uniform is issued. This is not refundable.
- 4) Any lost or poorly maintained piece will be replaced at the cost listed above by the student's family in question.

A District Maintenance Fund has been established to repair or correct common issues with High School Music program instruments. This includes (but is not limited too): cleaning, Missing/Failing pads, Missing/Failing Cork pieces, Head joints, ligatures, mouthpieces etc.
