



Frequently Asked Questions - Widow's Retreat

Who may attend?

The Widows' One-Day Retreat is open to widows of all ages. Whether your loss was recent or many years ago, you are warmly invited to join us for a day of encouragement, fellowship, and renewal. Registration is coordinated through participating churches.

What is included in the cost?

The retreat fee is **\$25 per person** and includes:

- Continental breakfast
- Homemade lunch
- Three inspirational sessions
- Craft activity
- Pampering time (paraffin wax hand treatment, hand and forearm massage, and sugar scrub)
- Retreat materials
- Door prize opportunities

What should I wear?

Dress comfortably and casually. You'll be indoors for most of the day, so we recommend comfortable clothing and walking shoes. You may also want to bring a light sweater or jacket if you tend to get chilly indoors.

Is Manderley Christian Camp wheelchair accessible?

Yes. Our main retreat facilities are wheelchair accessible. If you use a wheelchair, walker, or have other accessibility needs, please note them on your Registration & Waiver Form so we can prepare for your visit and make your day as comfortable as possible.

What if I have dietary restrictions?

We are happy to accommodate most dietary needs whenever possible. Please list any food allergies or dietary restrictions on your Registration & Waiver Form by the registration deadline so our kitchen staff can prepare accordingly.

What if I need transportation?

Many participating churches provide transportation for their attendees. If you need a ride, please speak with your church coordinator or church office. They will let you know if transportation is available from your church.

May I come alone?

Absolutely! Many women attend on their own, and you'll be warmly welcomed. Our hope is that you'll quickly feel at home, make new friends, and enjoy meaningful fellowship throughout the day.

What if I have special mobility needs?

We want every guest to have an enjoyable experience. If you have difficulty walking, need assistance with stairs, use a mobility aid, or have any other special accommodations, please note them on your Registration & Waiver Form. Our team will do everything we can to make your visit comfortable.

Is there a refund policy?

Registration forms, signed waivers, and payment must be received by **August 15**. Because meals, supplies, and retreat materials are purchased in advance, **no refunds can be issued after August 15**. If you are unable to attend before the deadline, please contact your church coordinator as soon as possible.
