Policy Recommendation to Address Adverse Health Effects of PFAS in Drinking Water

Sept. to Dec. 2025

- Analyzed prevalence of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) in Massachusetts drinking water systems considering environmental justice populations to assess community needs
