Course Duration: 2 years

Credit Hours: 75 hours (including 15 minor credit hours)

Program Description

The Associate in Theology and Ethics program with a Specialization in Faith-Based Leadership equips students to explore core theological doctrines, Christian ethics, and principles of servant leadership. Rooted in scripture and spiritual formation, this program trains students to lead with integrity, compassion, and moral clarity in diverse ministry and nonprofit settings.

Students will study biblical theology, ethical decision-making, leadership models, and social responsibility, while gaining hands-on experience in community ministry, discipleship training, and advocacy. Emphasis is placed on living out theological convictions through responsible and relational leadership.

Graduates may pursue leadership roles in churches, parachurch organizations, faith-based nonprofits, or continue their theological education.

- Leading a church-wide ethics seminar or outreach event.
- Developing a leadership training model for youth ministry teams.

- Support faith-based organizations through teaching, service, and leadership.
