LESSON TITLE: Day of Trees	LESSON GOAL : The students will learn about Arbor day and practice color skills by creating a tree collage.
INTRODUCE THE BOOK/STORY: (Read the story or use the video link.)	Learn more by viewing this short video: What Is Arbor Day?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: (Check for Understanding)	Why are trees important?Where were trees first planted for Arbor Day?
SUPPLIES NEEDED: Construction paper, pastels or chalk, or crayon, collage materials	ACTIVITY INTRODUCTION: We will be making a beautiful Tree collage to honor the beauty of trees.
ACTIVITY (Students should do their own work):	Tree Collage Tree Collage
CLOSING:	Have the students show off their art and talk about what is similar and different in the pictures.
GROUP GAME: Developmental Goal: To increase cognitive abilities such as memory, attention, and making decisions. Equipment Needed: Playground or Gator balls.	 Read through the game instructions ahead of time so that you can teach the activity. Use an attention-getter to gather students and make sure they are listening.
