You must be writing according to the Author Guidelines. The systematics of the research articles are the title, author's name (along with the institution's address and e-mail address), abstract (with keywords), introduction, method, results and discussion, conclusion, and references.

The title of the article is no more than 12 words. The name of the author of the article is listed without an academic degree, accompanied by the name of the institution the e-mail of the author, placed under the title of the article. If more than one person writes the manuscript, the e-mail listed is only the e-mail of the main author (correspondence author). See also AUTHOR GUIDELINES (12 pt 1.15 spacing).

### Method (12 pt bold)

The method contains an explanation in the form of paragraphs about research design, data sources, data collection techniques, and data analysis. (12 pt 1.15 spacing).

### Results and Discussion (12 pt bold)

The research results and discussion contain an explanation of the results of the analysis related to the research objectives. The discussion includes an analysis of the results and discussions with theories and similar research results. This section can be completed with tables or figures related to the discussion.
