- To Enhance Employability Skills.

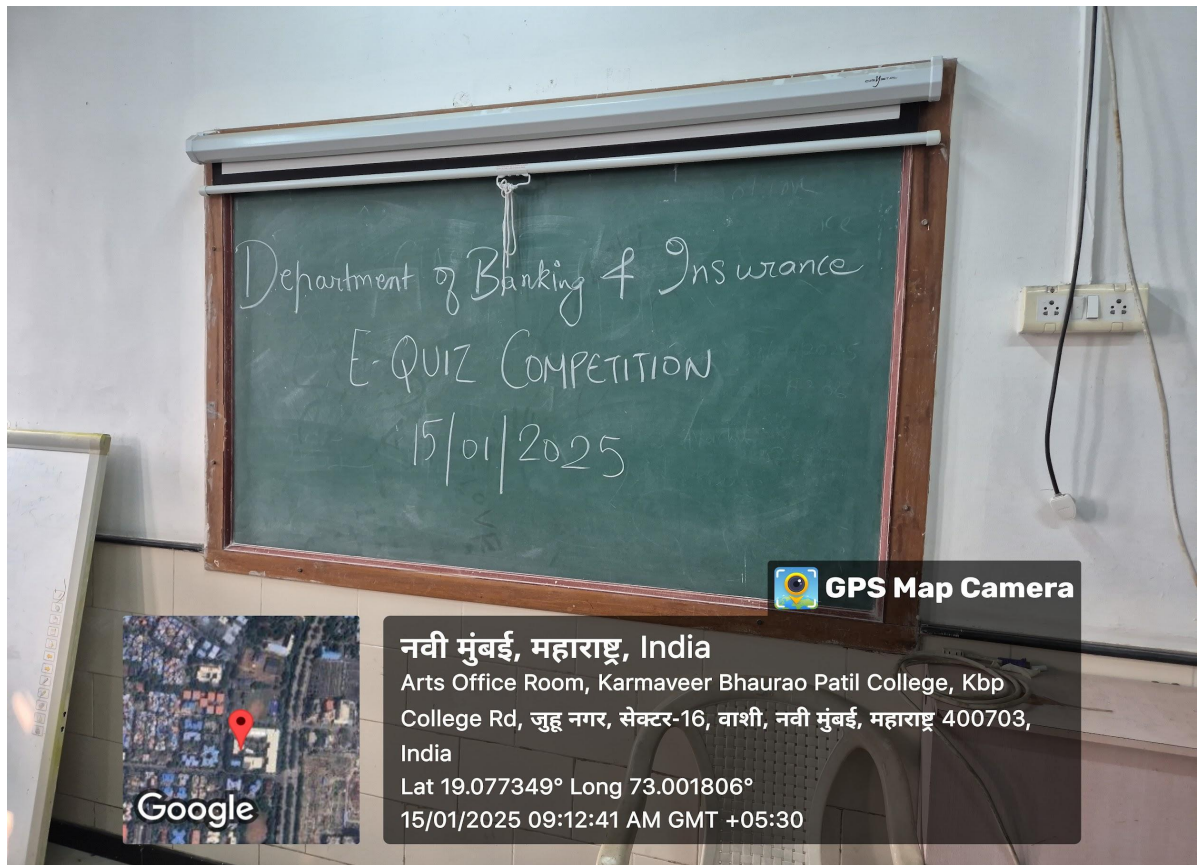
Outcomes:

A total of 48 students participated in this activity conducted during the departmental annual fest- “RESONANCE”.

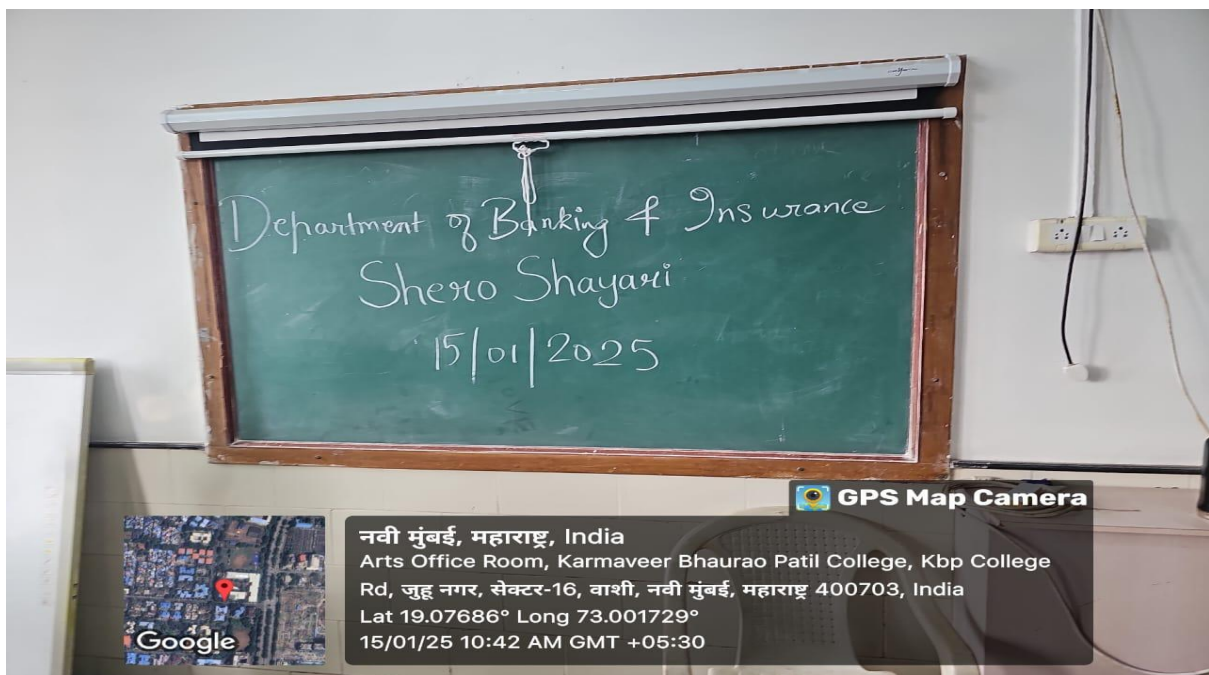
