We are so pleased that you are applying for an SBHS “Always a Don” Alumni Association scholarship! **This scholarship is for SBHS alumni who have already graduated from high school.**

All application materials are due by Wednesday, January 28, 2026 at midnight. No late applications will be accepted.

Requirements:

1. Must have attended SBHS for at least 4 semesters.
2. Attach transcript (unofficial is acceptable) from last school attended.
 - a. GPA of 2.5 or above (unweighted) for courses within the last 5 years.
 - b. Transcript may be waived if school last attended more than 5 years ago.
3. Attach a scan or photo of your FAFSA or California DREAM Act Application (CDAA) SAI (Student Aid Index)).
4. Submit a typed personal statement answering three 3 questions (details below). Include the school you will be attending and whether you are an undergraduate or graduate student.

Notification of award will be made by early April 2025. **This award will apply to the 2025-2026 academic year.**

All awards are in the form of a check sent to the institution where you will be enrolled and will be mailed upon receipt of our Verification of Enrollment Form and a personal thank you note from you.
