Highlights from the 25-26 Secondary Assessment Practices (9th/10th grade team)

Completion of Assignments

- Assignments will be due within the class period or by 6 p.m. per teacher discretion. The due date time will be indicated per assignment.
- Rubric-based formative assignments will be weighted at 5% or 25%. The formative weight will be announced when the formative is assigned. The corresponding summative score does not replace the formative score.
- There is no grace period (no late window) except for students with accommodations (extended time per their IEP/504) and students with an absence (a one-class-day extension per class day absent).
- Missing formative assignments must be turned in <u>prior to</u> the corresponding summative due date in order to regain the opportunity to redo the summative, but <u>the formative zero will remain in Skyward, and</u> <u>the student may not receive teacher feedback</u>.

Redo Opportunities

- Students who fail to turn in corresponding Formatives prior to the Summative <u>WILL</u> forfeit the chance to redo said Summative. Since each formative is meant to help you grow and achieve your best success on a summative, formatives are crucial and required for any summative redo opportunity.
- Students who do not make an <u>earnest</u> attempt in the completion of a Summative <u>WILL</u> forfeit the chance to redo said Summative. Please refer to the "Summative Redo" section of the document above (Secondary Assessment Practices).
- Please be aware that each teacher within the 9th/10th grade team may require tutorials, conferencing, or completion of work in preparation for a Summative Redo, based on the skills required for success.

Academic Honesty

• If a teacher suspects that a student has not been principled in the completion of academic work, the student will be referred to the assistant principal to determine any necessary consequences. Students applying to the National Honor Society need to be aware that academic dishonesty may prevent admission to the NHS.

- Please see pages 3-5 of <u>Meridian's Academic Integrity Policy</u> for student responsibilities and examples of academic dishonesty (also called "breaches of academic integrity"). When unsure, students should ask their teachers for clarity so that teachers can best support them.
- If a student is found violating the Academic Honesty policy, they may redo the assignment if conditions set by the teacher and/or administrator are met. These may include: an alternative assignment, tutorials, a student-written reflection about academic dishonesty, or a requirement to complete the summative task on paper and/or in the presence of a Meridian staff member.
