Thornton Central School has received a draft allocation of \$444,307.08 through the ARPA ESSER III grant. The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) includes a third round of the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER III), as well as money for internet connectivity for schools and libraries, the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), and extension of the Pandemic EBT food program for students. Funds received can be used during the following school years; 2021-2022, 2022-2023, and 2023-2024. Districts receiving funds are required to set aside 20 percent of the funds to address learning loss.
