ABSTRACT

It places primary emphasis on the outcomes of the service. The abstract must be written in **English**, with a length between **150 and 300 words** formatted as a single paragraph. The left and right margins should be narrower than the main body text. While the first line is not indented, the keywords immediately following the paragraph must be italicized and indented. For the English version, use the **past tense** (except for conclusions or recommendations) and define all abbreviations or acronyms

INTRODUCTION

(Times New Roman 12 pt, 1.5 Spacing)

The introduction should primarily include: (1) situational analysis; (2) problems; (3) proposed solutions; and (4) target outputs. The situational analysis describes the issues faced by the target community regarding social, cultural, religious, health, or quality of life aspects. It may also detail potential business opportunities involving resources, production, or management. Based on this analysis, authors must identify specific, concrete, and high-priority problems. Describe the technology, goods, or services offered as solutions, including the work procedures and the level of partner participation. Specify the planned outputs, whether they are products, services, or management improvements. The body text uses **Times New Roman 12 pt** and should be approximately **1-2 pages** long without subheadings.

METHODS AND IMPLEMENTATION

This section details the execution of the community service, including location, timing, and participant demographics (background and quantity). 2. Demonstrate outputs as indicators of program success.
3. Identify supporting or inhibiting factors during implementation.

Results must be measurable, supported by data from questionnaires, pre/post-tests, or partner feedback.

- **Tables and Figures:** Table titles are placed **above** the table, while figure captions are placed **below**.
- **Equations:** Use **Times New Roman** or **Symbol** fonts, with sequential numbering in parentheses (1) on the right margin.

CONCLUSION

The conclusion summarizes the results and discussion relative to the community's problems. It should outline supporting and hindering factors, while recommendations should be based on the project's strengths, weaknesses, and potential for sustainability

Briefly state appreciation for sponsors or specific contributors. Avoid excessive or hyperbolic statements.

References must follow **APA Style (6th Edition)**. A minimum of **25 sources** is required, consisting of **80% journal articles** (published within the last 5 years) and **20% books** (within the last 10 years). All cited works must appear in the reference list, and all listed references must be cited in the text. Use of reference managers like Mendeley or Zotero is highly recommended
