JON Yes, there are.

JON Yes! Lots of girls are getting interested in them now. They are often as good as boys, or better!

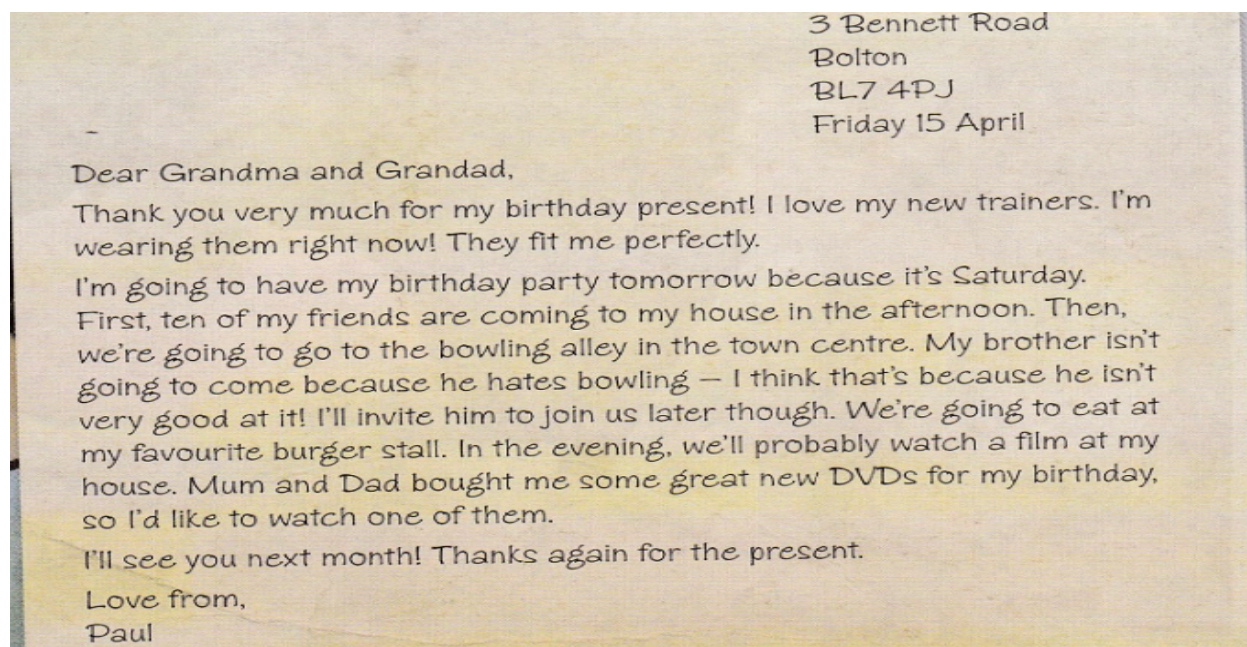
