

How to Be Successful with SDL HSBP

HIGH SCHOOL & BEYOND REQUIREMENT

In order to meet the “High School & Beyond” requirement on your transcript, you must complete and pass all required HSBP assignments.

GRADING

All assignments are graded pass/fail. A 2.8 to a 4 is a passing grade. If you earn below a 2.8 (70%), revision is required. Be sure to carefully review assignment checklists and rubrics before turning in assignments.

ASSIGNMENT TIPS

Read for Details

Read assignment overviews and directions carefully. Follow directions.

Writing

Your writing should reflect the fact that you are in college. All writing should be high quality and free of errors. Be sure to meet minimum requirements. These are provided to give you an idea of how developed your written responses should be.

Avoid Zeros

Assignments that do not follow directions and/or have poor quality writing and careless errors will be returned for revision.

Ask Questions

If something is unclear or confusing, ask for clarification. Since we don’t have face-to-face meetings, I expect you to contact me when you have questions. I am happy to set up a virtual meeting if that is helpful to you.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM TIPS

Use Your GoTahoma Account

Any time you are working on an assignment, use your GoTahoma account, not another Google account. You cannot upload assignments from another Google account. If you cannot access your account, call the Technology Help Desk at 425-413-3230. If they do not answer, leave a message. They will return your call, but it may take awhile. Do not leave multiple messages; it just slows things down.
