Mapping in Sheffield


Phase 1 Questions

Overview

Building on <u>this outline</u> of the rationale for rethinking how we map places, things and interactions in Sheffield, this document sets out the provisional question set for phase 1 of this work.

Aim of phase 1: To identify, define and visualise existing ideas of place, network or identity in Sheffield as a platform for layering up how these things interact with resources, assets, services and relationships in the city during subsequent phases.

An outline of the process...



The core phase 1 question sets

Minimal demographic / personal information (TBC)

Router: How would you like to engage with this? Pick as many as you like...

- By commenting on existing ideas of neighbourhoods as a list of places

- By clicking on existing ideas of neighbourhoods on a map and answering some questions about them from there
- By drawing your own neighbourhood(s) and networks and naming them yourself

To what extent do you identify with any of the following pre-existing ideas of place or network? [Likert scale attached to place names, boundaries and/or networks]

From your own perspective, what name would you use to describe the place where you live within Sheffield

Using the map, draw the boundary of that place.

Is there anything within that place that feels particularly important within that place and how you see it? If it's an X, what is it called?

Are there any other places or networks that are particularly important to you? What are they called? Can you draw them?
