Elementary & Secondary Education Act: Parent Right to Know

Federal law requires teachers to be qualified in the subjects they teach. This law, called the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), required all teachers meet our state certification and licensure requirements in order to teach in schools receiving federal funding. All teachers in Princeton Elementary School meet this definition and are dedicated to the success of every student in their classroom. Parents have the right to request any of the following information about their child's teacher from the school principal. If you have other questions concerning ESEA, Please contact Charity Williams at 796-2253.

- Whether the teacher has met the certification requirements of the state.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or other provisional status.
- The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher in the field or discipline of his or her certificate or degree.
- Whether or not the child is provided service by a paraprofessional, and if so, his or her qualifications.
