lo-bit music refers to a number of aesthetic and / or technical aspects of many, though not all, of the artists being presented. The title relates both the minimalism that is at times on display, with the 1's and 0's (lo) implicitly underlying digital technology. Generations that were born with or raised by the computer revolution are working now to redefine their relationships with the machines that are changing the world.
