- School store - opened up on 11/5, for grades k-2, it is held in the cafeteria and students can come up and shop during lunch. This will be held once a month, and we will be sending out a physical flyer that will have a visual for parents to see what we are selling; also check out our socials to see what we have for sale. For our first time we made a little over \$400! If you are a paid PTO member you can volunteer from 11-1 for our school store!
- Book fair - happening now (11/10-11/14) and we are off to a great start! We are doing a contest this week for pre-K/k and 1st/2nd - pre-K/k students will guess how many erasers are in the jar to win the book Eraser, and the 1st/2nd graders will guess how many candles are in the jar to win Diary of a Wimpy Kid: Party Pooper. When classes come down, students will get to submit a guess. We can always use volunteers so the sign up sheet is still open.
