• Application deadline: Currently Closed

 Qualifications: Students must volunteer within their communities and be enrolled in a post-secondary institution for the upcoming academic year.

## **TN Future Teacher Scholarship**

Did you know? The Tennessee Future Teacher Scholarship is a loan-scholarship program intended to encourage exemplary students to enter the teaching field in Tennessee! This scholarship is a state based scholarship available to students meeting the qualifications outlined under "qualifications" to the right.

- Amount: For students attending an eligible institution, the award amount will be \$1,750 per semester up to a maximum of \$3,500 per academic year.
- Application Deadline: Students must complete and submit the scholarship application no later than September 1st for fall semester, March 1st for spring semester, and May 1st for summer semester.
- Availability: Participation is limited to college juniors, seniors, and post-baccalaureate students admitted to an

## **Community Foundation of Greater Memphis**

#### **Community Scholarships**

Did you know? The Community Foundation is proud to offer more than \$150,000 in 30 categories in scholarship funds to students from the Memphis area. Most scholarship opportunities we offer were created to honor a different person, profession, school, or educational goal. Most are for graduating high school seniors.

- Amount: Up to \$4,000 per year based on GPA
- Application deadline: Currently closed.
- Availability: Freshman & Transfer Students
- Qualifications: Minimum of 2.5 GPA

## **Memphis City Council**

#### **HBCU Scholarship Fund**

**Did you know?** The Memphis City Council HBCU scholarship fund offers up to 15,000 who will attend or currently are attending an accredited historically black college or university.

- Amount: Up to \$15,000 per year based on GPA
- Application deadline: Currently closed.
- Availability: Freshman & Transfer Students
- Qualifications: Minimum of 2.0 GPA

## **Regions Riding Forward Scholarship**

### Regions Riding Forward Scholarship

Did you know? Being a member of Regions bank is not a requirement for this scholarship. Students can apply on a rolling basis. This means there is an application deadline for each semester the student plans to enroll. 4 students will be awarded each contest.

- Amount: \$8,000
- Application deadline: Currently Open from 07/01/25, due on 09/30/25.
- Availability: Incoming Freshman & Transfer Students
- Qualifications: Must maintain a 2.0 GPA or be in "good standing" with the accredited institution. A written or video essay is required.

#### **Leaders Education Foundation**

#### **Scholarship Fund**

**Did you know?** Leaders Education Foundation will award scholarships of various amounts to West Tennessee students attending an accredited college or university of their choice or enrolled in a workforce readiness program.

- Amount: up to \$1,000 per award
- Application deadline: Currently open, due by August 1, 2025.
- Availability: Freshman & Transfer
  Students
- Qualifications: Must be a member to apply, you become a member by paying \$10

## **Pride Scholarship Fund**

Did you know? Jackson Pride aims to bring awareness and understanding of the LGBTQIA community to Jackson, Tennessee through community involvement, projects, events, and educational resources. Jackson Pride celebrates diversity and provides support to the LGBTQIA community and its allies.

- Amount: Up to \$7,500 per year
- Application deadline: Currently Open April 30, 2026 Deadline
- Availability: Incoming Freshman
- Qualifications: No GPA Minimum, but students are required to submit transcripts, ACT scores, resume, and an essay

## **Community Foundation of West Tennessee**

### **Sam Bomar Memorial Scholarship**

**Did you know?** The Community Foundation manages over 20 scholarship funds. Some scholarships help students from a particular school or area; others provide financial assistance to those pursuing a specific field of study.

## **Asphalt Institute Foundation**

### **Bill & Shireen Kirk Scholarship Fund**

Did you know? Scholarships from this fund will be awarded annually to third or fourth year undergraduate, masters, or doctoral students who exhibit need and are interested in pursuing degrees in a civil engineering or pavement infrastructure-focused major, with an emphasis on asphalt materials and its use.

- Amount: \$3,000 per year for 2 years
- Application deadline: Must complete application by February 15<sup>th</sup>
- Availability: Incoming Freshman
- Qualifications: Minimum 3.0 GPA & 23 ACT Score, Be a resident of Madison County
- Amount: Varies
- Application deadline: Currently closed.
- Availability: Transfer Students
- Qualifications: Must be interested in pursuing degrees in business, chemistry, civil engineering, construction management, marketing/sales, or a pavement infrastructure-focus
