

Engage All Student with Smartboard – How did she do that?

- #1 Pull Tab Search for "tab" and look in folder Interactive Multimedia. Always click on the pin to set it when it is off of the page. You can type whatever you'd like on the tab.
- #2 Teach the students SMART Notebook software. Located in the My Applications folder on all FCPS machines at Irving.



#6 Flip the activity. Write words in a text box. Be sure to use double spacing and color the words the

same as background. Draw a rectangle that will cover the words. Use the animation option Flip around Axis and Bottom Edge. Right click and choose Order – Send to Back.



- #7 Duplicate activity slides for each student. Use CNTL D to duplicate slide you have selected.
- #8 Movement. Any diagram or sorting on the board can be recreated with the student bodies in class. Create contrasting text and boxes. Be sure text matches background color. Be sure to send the box objects to the back.
- #9 Split Screen using a slate or Interwrite tablet. Group students throughout the class with technology or not. Click the Dual/Single Page display button
- #10 Allow Choice of lesson. Right click on the object and choose Link. Select the page in the notebook to go to on click.
- #11 Predicting and Sequencing. Bill of Rights. Insert a table and write in each of the terms or text needed. Right click on each cell and choose Cell Shade.

#12 Photographs. Science experiments, posters, drawings, or drama. Choose Insert – Picture File. Select multiple files with the CNRL click option and then click OK. For each of the photos, create a black slide. Click and drag each to the blank slide.

#13 Student Designed pages in PowerPoint. Save them as JPG in the PowerPoint option Save As. Import as above with Photos.

#14 Add an Idea. Fill the whole board from a general concept. Be sure and use various colors.

#15 Post your notebooks. In Blackboard, simply upload the notebook file as is. Students can use <u>Smart Notebook Express</u> to view the files. Be sure and give them a link to either view online or download the program.
