Prompt:

Compare and contrast Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and Malcolm X as people, Civil Rights activists, and orators.

Must include a Works Cited page, no matter which format you choose!

You must cover the following topics/issues:

- Where they were born
- Their upbringing
- Their childhood and young adult events
- The people who influenced and inspired them
- Their religions or beliefs
- How they reacted toward the treatment of their fellow African Americans
- Their audiences
- Their message to their audiences about Civil Rights
- Their way of speaking to their audiences
- Their deaths
- Their impact on American history (what did they ultimately accomplish)
- How they are remembered (their legacies)

You may choose one of the following formats to complete your project:

- Google Slide Presentation or Prezi
- Google Doc - Essay format
- Written Essay - ~5 paragraphs
- Poster Board (must provide your own)
- Video Production (interview style [you & partner], you reading your presentation,
- Blog (blogspot is viewable on District computers)
- Twitter (MLK vs. MX both Tweet to each other. You will have to create two Twitter accounts, write the Tweets, then take screen shots, then print out the Tweets. I cannot pull up Twitter on District computers). **Cannot be done at school! Must be done entirely at home!**

- Facebook (MLK vs. MX on Facebook. You will have to create two FB accounts, have MLK and MX post on each other's pages. You will have to take screen shots, then print them out. I cannot pull up FB on District computers). **Cannot be done at school! Must be done entirely at home!**
- Have another idea? Must submit the idea to me for approval.
