Author Guidelines

To ensure high quality and uniformity in the Cable Wire 2026 (10th Edition) Conference Proceedings, authors must adhere to the following updated guidelines, which reflect the best current practices for technical conferences.

1. Submission Format

- **Files Required:** Full paper in editable Word format (.docx).
- **Submission:** Email Paper along with Author (s) biodata to:
- **Template:** Use the official Cable Wire Conference 2026 (10th Edition) template:
 - Sample Paper
 - For Biodata
- **Language:** Ensure correct grammar, spelling, and a professional tone. Papers not meeting language standards may be returned for revision.

2. Formatting Specifications

Footer	Center: Page numbers (e.g., 1-4, 2-4)

3. Title and Author Details

- **Title:** Centered, Arial Bold, 14 pt, ALL CAPITALS, maximum two lines, 6 pt before, 24 pt after.
- **Author(s):** Centered, Arial Bold, 11 pt, Upper/Lower case, 0 pt before, 6 pt after.
- **Affiliation & Location:** Centered, Arial, 11 pt, Upper/Lower case, 0 pt before, 12 pt after. Include organization and city/country (not full address).

4. Heading Structure

Main Heading	Double column, left, Arial Bold, 11 pt, ALL CAPS, 12 pt before, 6 pt after	INTRODUCTION
Sub-Heading	Double column, left, Arial Bold, 11 pt, Title Case, 6 pt before, 3 pt after	Design Aspects
Sub-sub Heading	Double column, left, Arial, 11 pt, Title Case, 6 pt before, 3 pt after	Test Results

5. Mathematical Content

- Use MS Word's equation editor for all equations.
- For complex equations, insert high-resolution images (minimum 300 dpi) if necessary.
- Center equations/images in-line for clarity.

6. Figures, Tables, and Images

- **Tables/Graphs:** Create in Excel, embed in Word, number consecutively, and add clear captions.
- **Diagrams:** Insert as high-resolution images (minimum 300 dpi), captioned as Fig. 1, Fig. 2, etc.
- **Photographs:** Use only original, high-resolution images (minimum 300 dpi). Caption appropriately.
- **Placement:** Position visuals near their first reference in the text.

7. Author(s) Biodata with Photographs

- Submit a brief biodata (maximum 100 words) for each author separately (do not include within the paper).
- Include: current affiliation, designation, area of expertise, and email address.
- Submit a recent digital photograph (.jpg or .tiff) for each author (main and co-authors) along with the biodata.
- **Photograph Requirements:** Minimum 300 dpi; size 55 mm x 45 mm (to allow cropping for publication).

8. Declaration of Originality and AI Usage

- **Originality Statement:**

Attach a signed declaration:

"This paper is the original work of the authors and has not been published or presented elsewhere in India or abroad. All sources are appropriately cited."

- **AI Usage Disclosure:**

- Declare if AI tools (e.g., ChatGPT, Copilot, Gemini) were used for drafting or editing.
- Specify tools used, their contribution, and confirm authors' critical review for accuracy.
- Example:

"Portions of this manuscript were generated/edited with the assistance of [AI tool name]. The authors have reviewed and take full responsibility for the content."

- **Screening:**

All submissions will be screened for plagiarism and AI-generated content.

Unacknowledged AI usage or plagiarism may lead to rejection.

9. Ethical and Responsible Use of AI

- AI tools may be used for language correction, summarization, or data analysis but should not replace the authors' intellectual contribution.

- Analysis, interpretation, and conclusions must be the authors' original work.
- If AI is used for image/data generation, state this clearly in captions and the methods section.
- Do not submit work entirely generated by AI without human oversight and value addition.

10. Additional Recommendations

- **Proofreading:** Check for clarity, coherence, and technical accuracy before submission.
- **Deadlines:** Strict adherence to submission deadlines is expected.
