## **BILL**

Be it Enacted by the Senate of the Wake Forest University Student Government here assembled,

- **SECTION I:** art. I, § 4 of the Wake Forest Student Government Constitution shall be stricken and all subsequent sections of Article I of the Constitution shall be renumbered accordingly.
- **SECTION II:** art. I, § 5 of the Wake Forest Student Government Constitution shall be stricken and all subsequent sections of Article I of the Constitution shall be renumbered accordingly.
- **SECTION III:** art. IV, § 1 of the Wake Forest Student Government Constitution shall be amended as follows: "The Board of Investigators and Advisors [Student Conduct Advisors, Office of the Dean of Students, Title IX Office], the Honor and Ethics Council, and the Judicial Council comprise the Judicial System of the University. The Student Government shall exercise its rights to advocate for the rights of students in these processes. All relevant and accurate information about the rules governing and functions of these groups can be found on their websites or through the Office of the Dean of Students."

**SECTION IV:** This bill shall take effect immediately upon passage.
